

## OPEN TO ALL SENIORS

### ETHEL GLEASON HOKSER SCHOLARSHIP

This scholarship is given by the Minden High School Alumni Association in the name of Ethel Gleason Hokser, Class of 1921, in honor of her appreciation and faithfulness to the Minden High School Alumni Association and her support for higher education.

This Scholarship Fund shall remain in perpetuity at the Minden Exchange Bank and Trust.

This scholarship shall be awarded to a Minden High School Senior who is dedicated to school, church, community, state, and nation. This scholarship shall be used by the recipient to continue advanced study at a selected institution of higher education. The recipient shall receive the scholarship money from the Alumni Association Treasurer upon a paid receipt of the student's first semester tuition. The Alumni Association Treasurer is Barbara Nichol, 141 South Nance, Minden, NE 68959.

### APPLICATION PROCESS

A student desiring to be considered by the award committee should **submit a letter of application** to the guidance office by **March 26<sup>th</sup>**. In the letter the student should comment on how English, math, history, government, and science are universal subjects. These subjects are needed by individuals for them to know and understand that the present and the future are built on the past, and that these subjects are relevant for their continued education and in everyday life.

### AWARDS COMMITTEE

The committee for awarding the scholarship shall consist of a member of the Minden High School Alumni Association, a member of the Minden Education Association, a member of the Minden Ministerial Association, and MHS Guidance Counselor. The basis for awarding the scholarship shall be the completed application and the student's educational qualifications.

## **EDUCATIONAL QUALIFICATIONS**

English, math, history, government, and science are universal subjects needed by individuals for them to know and understand that the present and the future are built on the past, and that these subjects are relevant for their continued education and in everyday life.

It shall be the duty of the award committee to inform each student entering Minden High School of the educational qualifications required to receive this scholarship. They are as follows:

- (1) The student shall be able to use correct grammar in speaking and writing at all times including word meaning, correct usage, spelling, and appropriate sentence and paragraph structure.
- (2) They shall know, understand, and use the principles for arithmetic and be qualified to solve any given mathematical problem.
- (3) They shall have thorough knowledge of American history and old world or modern world history.
- (4) They shall have thorough knowledge of both state and national governments.
- (5) They shall be trained in using the principles and methods for scientific research and have an understanding and knowledge of chemistry, physics, or natural sciences.

It shall be the duty of the awards committee to select a student who has fulfilled the educational qualifications set forth by the Minden Alumni Association and Mrs. Hokser.

The amount of the scholarship to be awarded each year shall be determined by the Alumni Association Committee.
