



## KEARNEY/FRANKLIN COUNTY CATTLEMEN SCHOLARSHIPS

### BASIS FOR SELECTION OF SCHOLARSHIP RECIPIENTS

1. Candidate must be a son or daughter of a current, active dues paying Kearney/Franklin County Cattlemen member.
2. Must be a high school senior.
3. Must have a "C" or higher grade point average.
4. Must be enrolled or intending to enroll full time in any college or university that offers a bachelor degree; an approved vocation or trade school; a state accredited junior college; or an institution offering a registered nursing degree.
5. Scholarships are awarded on the basis of (1) academic achievement (2) beef industry involvement and (3) quality of application.

### AMOUNT OF SCHOLARSHIP AND DONOR

1. The amount of each scholarship shall be \$250.00.
2. The scholarships are awarded for one year.

### PROCEDURES FOR APPLYING

1. Applications can be obtained from the School Counselor of Minden High School, Franklin High School, Wilcox-Hildreth High School and Axtell High School or Larry Wilcox.
2. **Applications are due March 30<sup>th</sup>.** Please include application, a color or black and white photograph of the applicant, and references.

4. Awards will be given during Honors Night at the recipients' school.
